 1) A Candidate should be present in the 1st Year Examination in the respective subject with a minimum of 35% marks in each paper and 35% aggregate in each attempt.
 2) Minimum pass marks for individual papers of 1st Year under compulsory attendance is 35%.
 3) Blind, Deaf, Deaf & Dumb candidates as directed in the previous Edition of this Memorandum shall be eligible to appear in the examination with a minimum of 25% marks in each paper. The marks of these candidates will be converted into marks on a percentage basis as per the following table.  4) The Blind, Deaf & Dumb Candidates who have secured 25% marks in each paper and 25% aggregate in each attempt will be eligible to appear in the examination with a minimum of 25% marks in each paper and 25% aggregate in each attempt.
 5) Candidates who are exempted from the examination in any subject shall be eligible to appear in the examination in the other subjects with a minimum of 25% marks in each paper and 25% aggregate in each attempt.

 2) IN CALCULATING GRADE POINTS FOR THE 2nd YEAR
 3) For PRACTICALS EXAMINATION in each paper the marks shall be converted into marks on a percentage basis as per the following table.
